



## OVERVIEW OF THE REMOTE CONTROL



## **FUNCTIONALITY**

Button		Description/ function	
(1)	Open	Opens the curtains or blinds	
(N)	Close	Closes the curtains or blinds	
0	Stop	Stops the movement	
(3)	Channel +	Switches to the next channel. The LED indicator moves to the right	
(1)	Channel -	Switches to the previous channel. The LED indicator moves to the left	
⇧	Favourite	Allows users to quickly access their preferred curtain positions with a single press*	
P	Prg	The Program button, enables users to access programming functions**	




## Get started

## INSERTING THE BATTERIES


 Press the cover on the back of the remote control and slide it upwards to reveal the battery compartment.



 Insert the batteries, paying attention to match the (+) and (-) ends of the batteries with the symbols inside the battery compartment.



3. Slide the battery cover back into place.



## MOTOR PAIRING

The remote control needs to be paired with the Forest device before it can be operated.

To pair the remote control with the Forest motor or LED system, please refer to the user manual of the respective Forest motor or visit the webpage with all manuals and videos.

## 3. How to use

## CONTROL THE CURTAINS

- 1. Navigate with ( ) or ( )
- 2 LED indicates the channel number
- 3. Then press (1) or (1) to open or close the curtains
- 4. Press □ to stop the curtains from moving

## CHILD LOCK: LOCKS ALL PROGRAMMING FUNCTIONS

- 1. Press (P) for 10 seconds
- 2. LED flickers once
- 3. Repeat the above, to delete child lock

## SET NUMBER OF ACTIVE CHANNELS

You can choose to activate only the channels you use. You can do this as follows:

- 1. Press () & (2) for 3 seconds
- 2. Set the amount of active channels with the ( ) and ( ) buttons
- 3. Press ( ) to approve
- 4. The -o-o-o-o-o- LED flickers 3 times

Group function: When all LEDs are lit, all channels are operated simultaneously.

## SET UP FAVOURITES FUNCTION

With the Favourites function (分), you can determine the position to which the curtain should move for each channel. You can set this up as follows:

- 1. Select the channel for which you want to set the curtain position.
- 2. Then, move the curtain to the desired preferred position by pressing ((I)) or ()I(). By pressing  $\Box$ , you can stop the curtain at any desired position.
- 3. Once the curtain is in the desired position, press [2 seconds] (☆) and (□).
- 4. The curtain position is now set for the respective channel. NOTE: only one favourite position per motor can be saved, regardless of which channel is being used.
- 5. Press (☆) to move your curtain directly to the desired position.
- 6. If you want to remove the preferred position, first select the channel and move the curtain to the current Favourites position. Then, press [2 seconds] (☆) and (□). The Favourites position is now cleared.

Important: The Favourites function can only be set if the end positions are configured. This function only works with Forest motors that are equipped with the Forest Link protocol.

## How do I know if I need to replace the battery in my remote control?

- Check during use if the operating distance between the motor and the remote control is significantly shorter or if it responds less sensitively. This may indicate that the batteries are almost empty.
- · If the batteries are almost empty, an LED light will flash orange oooo-o-when a button is pressed to indicate. Replace the batteries as soon as possible.

## My remote control doesn't work at all.

- Check if the remote control has been paired correctly with the Forest product.
- Check if the batteries are inserted correctly. If the batteries are almost empty, you need to replace them.
- The EasyTouch® remote control only works with Forest devices, such as Forest Shuttle®, Forest tubular motors with internal receiver and Forest LED systems with RF receiver.

# I only have motors with the original protocol, and the response time is slower than I'm used to.

- Switch to the original RF protocol.
  Please note that the motors will need to be re-paired with the remote control afterward.
- Remove the batteries
- 2. Press ( ) & reinstall the batteries
- 3. the LED flickers 1x
