








Forest WiFi Smart Plug



LED Indicator			
Flashing Red and Blue			Smart Plug is in Pairing mode after reset
Blue			Smart Plug output is turned off
Purple			Smart Plug output is ON with WiFi connection
Red			Smart plug output is ON without WiFi connection
LED OFF			Smart Plug output is OFF without Wi-Fi Connection

Forest WiFi Smart Plug Installation

- 1. Insert the WiFi Smart Plug in a powered outlet
- 2. Download and install the Forest Connect App from the Apple App Store or Google Play Store.

3. Connect your mobile phone or tablet to your WiFi network.

Note: The WiFi Smart Plug only supports 2.4GHz networks.

During configuration the phone or tablet must be connected to the same WiFi network to wich the Smart Plug needs to be connected.

4. Activate the pairing mode on the Smart Plug: Push and hold the button for 6 seconds



5. Launch the Forest Connect app and follow the in- app instructions.





FAQ & Troubleshooting

1. What devices can I control using the Forest Smart Plug

- LED lightning of the Forest DS-XL LED curtainsystem (on/off function)
- Forest Wireless Connector (Art.no: 5201002270).
 When the Forest Wireless Connector is connected to the Forest Smart Plug every Forest product with a built-in RF receiver can be opened and closed.



- Smart Plug is powered on: The wireless connector sends a OPEN signal
- Smart Plug is powered off: The wireless connector sends a CLOSE signal

2. I don't see any lights on the Smart Plug

- Make sure the outlet used is powered
- The Smart Plug has no WiFi connection and is turned off
- Reset the Smart Plug: Push and hold the button on the Smart Plug for 6 Seconds. follow the in- app instructions to re- add the device

3. The Smart Plug won't connect to my WiFi network

- Reset the Smart Plug Push and hold the button on the Smart Plug for 6 seconds and repeat the in- app configuration process
- Make sure the right WiFi network was chosen
- Make sure the WiFi password was entered correctly
- Make sure the WiFi Smart Plug is within reach of the WiFi router
- Make sure the WiFi network is 2.4GHz. 5GHz is not supported

4. I want to hard-reset the Smart Plug to factory settings

Press and hold the button on the Smart Plug for 6 seconds. The Smart Plug will flash blue and red.
